What is the audition process? There is not one! Dancers must be age 14 by 09/30/18. There is an application that can be picked up in the office after 06/01. Upon receipt of the application, each applicant will be asked to come in for an interview. It will be determined after the application/interview process if dancers are ready to take on the commitment of the Protégé Team. Once accepted into the Protégé team a family meeting will be held to discuss individual goals for each dancer.
